Slip Knot and Chain

1. Make a loop with a 4"- 6" tail



2. Hook through the loop pull the tail in




3. Make a loop



4. Pull the tail to tighten the loop





6. To chain, hook the yarn



7. Pull it through the loop



8. Continue until you have your base chain



Single Crochet

1. Insert hook into first chain




2. Go through chain to hook the yarn



3. Hook the yarn and pull through both loops







Double Crochet









5.

- 1. Wrap the yarn one time around the hook
- 2. Insert into the chain or stitch
- 3. Hook yarn pull it through (3 loops on hook)
- 4. Hook yarn again, pull it through the first two loops
- 5. Hook yarn again, pull it through the last two loops

You have completed a double crochet. Below is a picture of four rows of single crochet with half a row of double crochet on top

Treble Crochet

- 1. Chain four
- 2. Wrap the yarn around hook twice
- 3. Insert the hook
- 4. Pull the yarn through
- 5. You have four loops on hook

- 6. Pull the yarn through first two loops
- Hook the yarn and pull through the next two loops
- 8. Repeat one last time
